CBAM has a direct impact on corporate competitiveness. Although the levy obligation lies with importers within the EU, the emissions intensity of suppliers now affects product pricing and sourcing decisions. As a result, CBAM compliance has become a critical management issue not only for EU importers but also for exporters across Japan and Asia. Meanwhile, frequent

updates to reporting requirements and the complexity of emissions data collection continue to challenge many companies.

Against this backdrop, accurate measurement and management of GHG emissions data have become urgent priorities across global supply chains. ASUENE leads Asia in the adoption of its carbon accounting platform for GHG measurement, reduction, and reporting, particularly among manufacturers, helping companies establish precise emissions data foundations. Through this partnership, ASUENE will combine CBAMBOO's advanced regulatory expertise in Europe with its own implementation capabilities in Asia to accelerate both regulatory compliance and decarbonization across international supply chains.
